












From Regional Meetings to the 40th EYCA Conference

1. Youth ecosystems essentials: the role of European Youth Card in advancing ecosystems for youth empowerment, Montenegro

2. Walk the Talk Seminar – Bridging Rural Youth and Cultural Heritage in Visegrád

Walk the Talk, brought together rural youth, cultural professionals, and policymakers to improve youth access to cultural heritage. Featuring interactive cultural routes and discussions on mobility, the seminar highlighted solutions for engaging young people with heritage in rural areas. Participants also attended the 13th Annual Advisory Forum on Cultural Routes of the Council of Europe, engaging in cross-border discussions about enhancing youth participation in heritage projects.



3. Urban youth participation and inclusive youth spaces, Andorra

This PA seminar, focused on leveraging the European Youth Card to enhance urban youth participation and inclusive spaces. Shared good practices, encouraged new signatories to the Partial Agreement, and positioned youth mobility as a public policy priority.

This ambitious endeavour delved into the lives of young people in rural areas, uncovering their challenges, opportunities, and aspirations. Over the course of a year, the project generated actionable insights and practical recommendations to better engage and support rural youth across Europe.

Key Outcomes:


- Published the Rural Youth Report and collected 100 ideas directly from young people in rural areas.
- Delivered 5 key recommendations for EYCA members and youth-focused entities.
- Hosted the Rural Youth Camp in Andalucía, Spain, bringing together 43 participants from over 30 countries.

From hands-on trainings to out-of-the-box events, lively debates, and meaningful postcards to MEPs, this creative and dynamic campaign had it all!


















